



What spaces can I rent at SLC Arts?

	seating	size & location	room features
Crafts Studio (room 229)	tables with seating for 15	700 square feet, second floor	appropriate for messy crafts; in use as active pottery studio; large chalkboard; slop sink down the hall; windows open fully for ventilation
Dance Studio (room 230)	up to 25 chairs available, space for additional chairs, 4 music stands available	700+ square feet, second floor	full wall mirrors; hardwood floors; large chalkboard; lots of natural light; windows open fully for ventilation
Board Room (room 125)	tables with seating for 12	200+ square feet, first floor	appropriate for presentations; projector to connect to laptops available upon request; sideboard space for refreshments; air conditioner; adjacent kitchenette with sink

- wi-fi access with password from SLC Arts available in all rooms
- free parking

	Solo/Meeting (solo rehearsal space/ free for attendees)	Lesson (one teacher, one paying student)	Class (paying participants)
one-time reservation (1)	\$5/hr	\$10/hr	\$20/hr
multiple slots reserved (2-5)	\$4/hr	\$8/hr	\$15/hr
recurring slot reserved (6+)	\$3/hr	\$5/hr	\$10/hr

- \$5 minimum down-payment at time of reservation; signed room rental agreement required
- you must reserve at least 1 hour of time
- **current SLC Arts members get 1 hour of free Solo/Meeting rental per year;** free hour is non-transferrable, but may be combined with other members to reserve a longer block of free time
